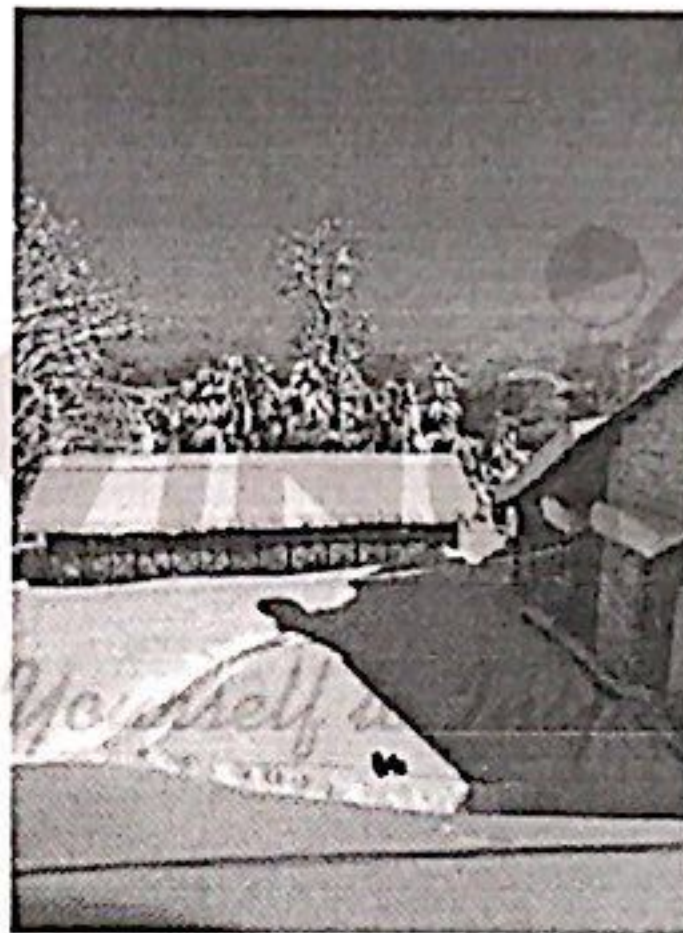
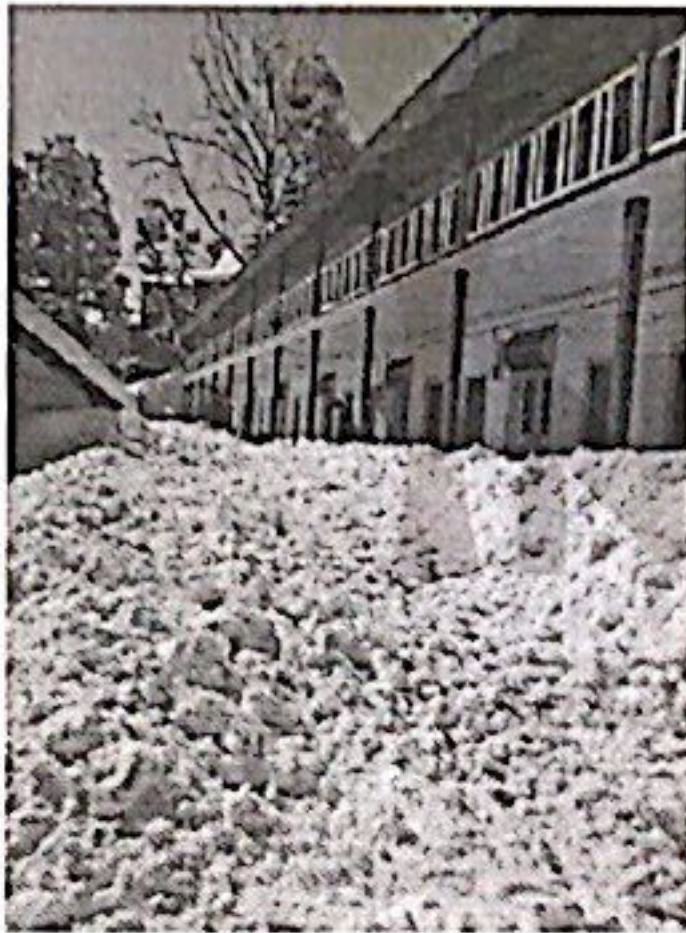


Updates: Heavy Snow Fall in Dalhousie

Heavy Snowfall was observed in Dalhousie in last few days resulting road blockages in higher altitudes and hence direct transportation with Kalatop Basecamp, Khajjiar & Dainkund Peak is not possible for near future. Looking at the weather conditions and feedbacks from local handlers, we have come to a conclusion and the below mentioned options are being proposed to all participants.



We have considered the facts that...

1. Many participants are students/professionals and they have registered for this camp long back. If the roads are blocked beyond Dalhousie, cancellation of the whole scheduled camp is not an option for them. Modification of the itinerary can be looked at.
2. A major portion of the amount has been paid as an advanced for Logistics or ticket booking to the local authorities/agencies/railways. In this case, full refund is not possible for Invincible.
3. There are other alternates for the proposed itinerary.

Looking at the best available options, we are proposing 3 options to all participants and asking them to revert with their best choices. It is necessary to revert back before 11 pm today otherwise the Option 1 will be considered as the participants' preference.

Option 1: Change in Itinerary

Keeping the accommodation at Dalhousie Hotel, the below mentioned schedule is a good option for snow trekking.

Day	Regular Itinerary	Proposed Itinerary
1	Departure from Ahmedabad	No Change
2	Arrival at Pathankot and then to Dalhousie	No Change
3	Free day for Dalhousie Sightseeing	No Change
4	Trek to Kalatop	Trek to Barapathhar
5	Trek to Dainkund	Trek to Panchpula
6	Visit Khajjiar Lake	Visit Chamera lake & Rockgarden
7	Departure from Pathankot	No Change
8	Arrival at Ahmedabad	No Change

Option 2: "Snow Trekking in Manali"

If the participants agree, and if they are ready to pay an amount of 1,000/-, which is basically the cost difference between Manali and Dalhousie packages, their registration can be shifted. More information of Manali: <http://bit.ly/2dY9oVZ>

Option 3: Cancellation

If the participants wish to cancel their participation, an amount between 50% - 60% can be refunded in a duration of 7 days.

Note: The weather conditions are not dangerous/risky and totally safe for visiting the places. The change in scheduled is proposed only due to inefficiency of transportation (for luggage, ration & in case of emergency).
