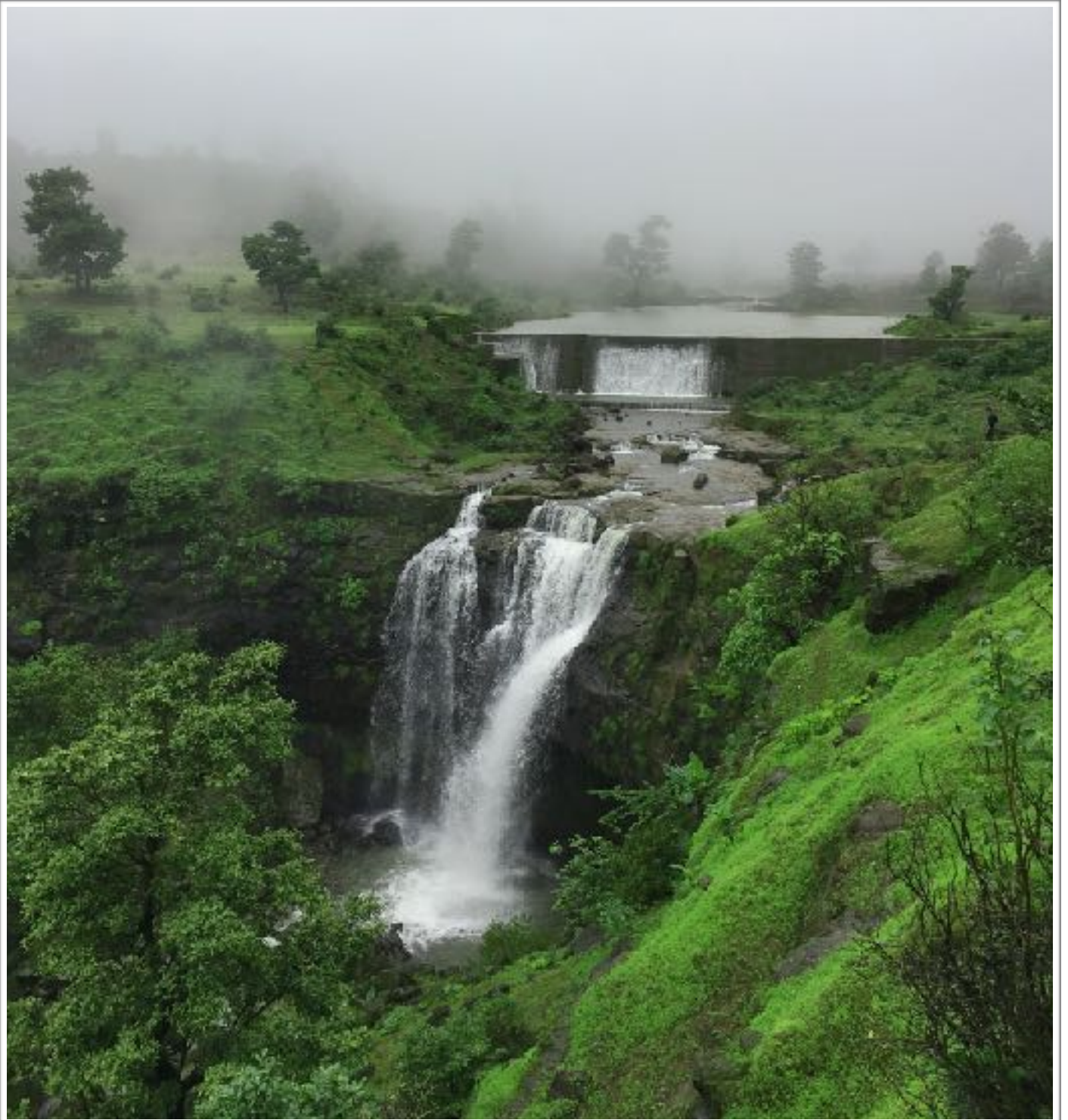

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About the Dangs!

Geography & People

Situated in the extreme South Eastern end of Gujarat, the District of Dangs is a tribal majority and hilly forests! Being a part of the Sahyadri Mountains, monsoon blooms here with all the colours!

Just with the beginning of rainy season, the area changes rapidly and lush green landscapes attracts the wanderers and nature lovers. Gushing streams and gentle waterfalls all around is the charm of the Dangs. When it is raining, it happens the best season to visit this area. The famous waterfalls of Gujarat: The Gira Falls, Girmal Falls and Don Waterfalls are situated in the Dangs. It is also the home for Saputara - the only hill station of the state and most importantly, Don - the emerging tourist destination.



People mostly depend on the seasonal agriculture and towns like Saputara has tourism too. Local people speak a mixture of Gujarati and Marathi and they wear cloths identical to Marathi people. Roads connecting the towns are very good and rural roads are comparatively broken during monsoon.

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History & Mythology

“Dangs” refers to the forest of bamboo trees!

The history says that Dangs are the *Dandakaranya of Ramayan*! Lord Rama stayed in this forest and there are multiple places having mythological importance like Pampa Sarovar, Shabari Dham, Anjani Kund and Pandava Caves. Dang Darbar is also a well known royal ritual.

The highest point of Dangs is the Don Hill! And surprisingly, the Don is derived from “द्रोण”, who was the teacher of Pandavas and Kauravas in the epic Mahabharat. Eventually is became Don in local language. Wanderers and trekkers attracted to it due to its scenic beauty and majestic waterfalls.



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Schedule & Itinerary

The Previous Day

- We will depart from Ahmedabad (near Gujarat University) on the previous night of the date shown on the website i.e. if 24th July is shown on website, the camp will leave on 23rd July 11 PM.
- The live location of the bus will be notified to the participants from Baroda, Surat and Bharuch.

Day 1: Gira Waterfall & Botanical Garden

- The camp will reach Waghai Botanical Garden followed by a 10 min halt at some hotel on the highway. After that we will have our breakfast and then will explore the Gira Waterfalls.
- After that, we will leave for Saputara Campsite.
- Campsite Setup, Tent Allotment and Lunch.
- Visit to Step Garden & Sunset Point.
- Back to Campsite, Dinner.

Day 2: Trek to Governor's Hill & Sightseeing

- Breakfast in the Morning and then depart for the trek.
- Hike to Governor's Hill and Table Point and back to Campsite for Lunch.
- In afternoon, visit Saputara Lake, Aquarium, Museum & Rose Garden.

Day 3: Don Hill Station & Don Waterfall

- After Breakfast, depart for Don Village.
- Visit Don Hill Station and then trek to Don Waterfalls.
- Depart for Ahmedabad after Lunch. Arrival at Ahmedabad late in the night.

Note: This is a tentative schedule and it can be changed with respect to weather and all other unforeseen conditions. The organisation has all the rights to modify/change /cancel the itinerary and that may / may not be informed to the participants.

- Safety & Security would be the main cause after such changes.
